Significance of Renaissance Thought

- **Humanism**: led to a better understanding of the human body and how to draw and sculpt it. Made people appreciate what people did more so than what God did.
- Individualism: people were more ready to rely on themselves and do what they wanted to do, regardless of their prior beliefs about what was right and good.
- **Classicism**: deepened study of and respect for ancient philosophy, ideas, and architecture.

Overall Significance of the Renaissance

- Willingness to break the norms of society
 - Desire to make reason the most important part of the human person
- New value in discovering things in the world
- More widespread secularism the separation of religion from society and the state
